## CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The Virginia Aviation Hall of Fame was created to commemorate and preserve outstanding aviation contributions made in Virginia or by Virginians. Many individual efforts have resulted in the pioneering, growth, or development of aviation and space exploration and must be recorded for future generations.

Each year, the Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society selects one or more individuals for recognition and induction into the Virginia Aviation Hall of Fame. Those men and women, in all phases of aviation, have demonstrated through their innovative ideas and dedicated services towards aviation development their concerns for our citizenry and contributed immeasurably to the welfare of our country.

## NOMINATIONS

The nominee's service or achievements in aviation must have been accomplished in the Commonwealth of Virginia and/or the nominee must be a native born Virginian.

Nominations may be made by any aviation organization, any member of the Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society, or by any firm or individual familiar with the nominee's achievements. However, each nomination must be submitted on an official nomination form supplied by the Society.

The Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society Board of Directors shall consider those nominees recommended by the Hall of Fame Selection Committee. The number selected each year shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

All nominees not selected will be considered for selection for two additional years without having to be nominated again. However, additional nominations or new supporting data in behalf of these persons may be submitted during the two year period.

No candidate shall be considered by the Selection Committee unless formally nominated in advance in accordance with these rules.

## FORMAT

- Three copies of each nomination must be submitted.
- Nominations must consist of the candidate's achievements, typewritten, double-spaced on two pages or less, and attached to the Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society Nomination Form.
- Each entry should include:
  - \* Achievements towards the enhancement of aviation.
  - \* Contributions to the development of others in aviation, i.e., pilots, mechanics, etc.
  - \* Service to Virginia in aviation activities either directly or indirectly.

## HALL OF FAME SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee is appointed by the Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society President and shall be composed of at least three active members of the Society.

All nominations shall be submitted to the Committee for review of completeness and eligibility. The Committee shall then recommend from the nominations a maximum of four entrants to the Hall of Fame each year. The recommendations shall then be submitted to the Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society Board of Directors for final selection.

## DEADLINE

Nominations must be received by the Virginia Aeronautical Historical Society no later than March 1.
